MONTAGUE TOWNSHIP SCHOOL BOARD ANNOUNCES CANDIDACY INFORMATION FOR THE APRIL 25, 2023 ELECTION

January 25, 2023 —The Montague Township School District has information available for citizens interested in running for the Board of Education.

Carl Morelli, the Montague Township Board Secretary, announced today that the Montague Township Board of Education will have four (4) vacancies in the April 25, 2023 Annual School Election. Three (3) vacancies are for a three (3) year term (April 2023 to April 2026) and one (1) vacancy is to fill the unexpired term of one year (April 2023 to April 2024).

A candidate must file a nominating petition with the School District Business Administrator for his or her name to appear on the ballot during the April Annual School Election. The deadline to submit the nominating petition is 4:00 p.m. Monday, March 6, 2023. The election is scheduled for Tuesday, April 25, 2023.

Prospective school board candidates can download candidate information from the New Jersey School Boards Association's web site at NJSBA School Board Candidate Kit. The School Board Candidate Kit includes information about nominating petitions, legal qualifications for school board candidacy, and the role of the school board member. Information about the New Jersey School Ethics Act and important dates in the school election process are also included.
