



## How to Clear Chrome's Cache and Cookies

1. Click the three vertical dots icon in the top-right corner of the screen, hovering over "More Tools," and then selecting "Clear Browsing Data."



NOTE: To go straight to the page to clear your cache and cookies, simultaneously press down on the Ctrl + Shift + Delete keys.

2. Make sure "Basic" is highlighted, then click the arrow in the box next to "Time Range" to expand the menu and then select "All Time".



- Next, check all 3 boxes Browsing History, Cookies And Other Site Data and Cached Images And Files.
- Once the boxes are checked, select the “Clear Data” button.

Frees up 317 MB. Some sites may load more slowly on your next visit.




- Once complete you can close ( X ) out of the chrome browser tab.

## Update to the latest Chrome browser - Manually Check for updates

1. To update Google Chrome on your computer, open Chrome Browser
2. At the top right, click on the 3 dots 
3. Slide down the menu to “Help”, then over to “About Google Chrome”



4. This will start to automatically search for updates. If there are new updates they will install
5. Once the update is complete you will need to click Relaunch.



NOTE: If you cannot find this button, you are on the latest version.
